### FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 165


The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 165 will hold a regular meeting on Thursday, July 10, 2025, at 9:00 a.m., at the offices of Municipal District Services, LLC, 406 W. Grand Parkway S., Suite 260, Katy, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

5. Authorize renewal of District's insurance policies.
6. Garbage and recycling collection matters.
7. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including:

  - b. adopt budget for fiscal year end June 30, 2026.
8. Tax assessment and collections matters, including:
  - a. delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills; and
  - b. authorize delinquent tax attorney to proceed with collection of delinquent taxes.

10. Report from Storm Water Solutions on maintenance of facilities.
11. Operation of District facilities, including:
  - a. billings, repairs and maintenance, customer appeals, back charges, and message language on water bills;

  - d. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.

    - iii. update on possible well improvements at water plants;
    - iv. Water Well No. 3;
    - v. Annual Water Plant Inspection;
    - vi. Water Plant Agreement; and
    - vii. TPDES Permit Renewal;
  - f. deeds, easements, and plats; and
  - g. MS4 Storm Water Management Plan.
15. Park and recreational development matters, including:
- a. authorize design of projects in the District, approve plans and specifications, and authorize advertisement for projects, if any;
  - b. review bids and award contracts for projects, including:
    - i. shade structure at Soledad Park; and
  - c. approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance for projects, if any.

- a. review Arbitrage Rebate Report for the Series 2020A Refunding Bonds; and
  - b. report regarding legislative matters.
